

There are no fancy costumes or ornate floats...no festive music or marching bands. But still the audience gathers, waiting patiently for the performers to arrive. As the sun sets over the Pacific, the show harmoniously begins. Just off the coast of Melbourne, Australia lies breathtaking Phillip Island. Over the years, travellers have flocked to this happy haven for one tiny reason: the Little Penguin. Measuring a mere one-foot high and weighing a meagre two pounds, the justly named bird has captured the attention and imagination of millions. At dusk, hundreds of Little Penguins return from their day-long feeding in the sea and parade up the beaches into their nests located in the sand dunes – seemingly unaffected by the many onlookers.
